Welcome to Class 2 🕹

Our cross-curricular project this term is called 'Flight'. Through a series of exciting activities the children will learn to carry out scientific investigations into how a hot air balloon works, test which materials will make the best plane and role play airport settings. They will also learn to use maps and globes to locate places and write postcards, diary entries and fact-files. Here is a brief overview of all the learning areas we hope to cover:

English: Write postcards, diary entries and fact-files.

Maths: Use Venn diagrams to sort organisms. As well as the children learning and extending their knowledge in number and place value, addition and subtraction, fractions, measurement and statistics. **Science**: Investigate and test hot air balloons. Make and test paper aero planes.

History: Recall information about the first flight and the jet era.

Geography: Use maps and globes, locate popular flight locations and learn about the migration of birds. **Computers:** Use software to explain the role of a pilot.

D&T: Create a junk model rocket ship.

Art: Use impressionist techniques to paint and use papier-mâché to create models.

Music: Use instruments to compose musical pieces.

PSHE: Discuss techniques for overcoming fears, discuss why we need passports to travel and why they keep us safe. As well as our Jigsaw scheme topics of 'Being Me in My World' and 'Celebrating Difference' to learn about respect and being unique.

PE: Undertaking multi-skills activities and gymnastics with our sports providers. They will also consider the value and effect of exercise on our bodies and that it can be a fun way to get fit!
