FOES are enrolled in various schemes that help to bring in fundraising contributions throughout the year. These don't raise a fortune but the funds all add up and the more people that take part, the more money will be raised for the school.

In September we received £14.53 from the Co-op as members of their Community Champions initiative. Lincolnshire Co-op donates money to local good causes - every time a member shops with the Co-op using their dividend card, a donation is made by the Co-op to a local charity or community group. You can make sure that donations raised from the Co-op by your shopping come to our school instead of another group - this is at no cost to yourself and Community Champions does not in any way effect your own personal members dividend.



Please:

1. Join this scheme at www.lincolnshire.coop/communitychampions
2. Select "Choose your own Community Champion"
3. Login to the members area (you will need your dividend card number, email address and you will be asked to set a password)
4. Select "Change Community Champions preferences"
5. Use the search facility to find "Eagle CP School", select them and logout. Your till receipt message when you shop will show that you are supporting Eagle CP School.

In October we received £7.50 from Label Planet's stikins clothing labels who donate 30% of name label orders back to the school so long as you quote our school number (35497) when you place an order. The labels can be used on other items like drinks bottles etc as well as clothing and don't come off in the wash.
