



SUNSHINE HOLIDAYS

A project about holidays by Key Stage 1

Overview:

What is most important about a holiday? Where should you go? How should you get there? Should it be fun? Should it be hot? So many decisions! Key Stage 1 set about exploring the world of holidays. Initially, the children recounted their holiday destinations and thought about modes of transport. They investigated where in the world it was, hot and cold and started to learn the names of the oceans and continents. They moved on to climates and thought about what to wear. When finally they were experts, they formed Sunshine Holidays, a company to find you the perfect holiday destination.

Facilitator Reflection:

The children learnt a lot about the world in this project. They had to put themselves in different places and used their knowledge to create holiday brochures for four themed destination holiday packages: skiing, safari, tent camping and a holiday camp. However, the best part was selling the holidays to parents: there were some fantastic questions from parents and equally persuasive answers from the children. Parents didn't know which holiday to pick!
