Autumn Term ~ Year 5&6

Hello! A big welcome back to children and parents. As we start our new school year, please utilize this newsletter to question your children on what they have been learning.

This term the children will undertake a project on **Space**. Parents, if you have any skills, resources or experiences that you could share with us on this topic that may aid us in our learning intentions, we would love for you to share them.

In our PROJECT lessons, we will explore Space. While traditionally taught the topic of Space in science lessons, Space will be expanded. We will investigate the history of space travel and astronomy from the earlier astronomers, such as, Galileo, to space pioneers like Neil Armstrong. Using our class novel, Orion Lost by Alistair Chisholm, we will discover the tools and the wills required to inhabit another world.

In mathematics, we will be going 'back to basics', in particular we will be focusing on place value and the four operations of calculation. Knowledge of multiplication facts is crucial for children to be able to progress well in later units, so please encourage your child to access TT Rockstars and Prodigy regularly to maintain their skills.

English learning will focus on writing a narrative looking at what happened before Chapter 1 of our class novel, Orion Lost, and subsequently, write a diary from the perspective of the main character of the book. Children will be introduced to, or recap, key grammar skills to aid in their writing, such as, relative clauses and varying sentence types. This will reacquaint them to the writing process and increase their stamina of writing.

In science, Earth and Space is our subject. Linking with our PROJECT, this will further knowledge covered in year 3/4, and allow for some interesting practical lessons and a chance to create a scale model of the solar system!

The children will be forming a company, a space-faring company that has been tasked with finding out everything necessary in travelling to and settling on another planet. They will have to have to endure various obstacles to ensure they reach the new planet.

PSHE will include using our new scheme, Jigsaw. Using familiar resources and styles, the children will learn, discuss and think about Being in my World: their place in it and what they can do.

In PE, the children will undertake various activities, led by Premier Education, to build up stamina and strength as well as playing as part of a team.
