Covid update ...

In considering the local landscape and high rates of Covid-19, to help give clarity on when to isolate, children, staff and other adults should not come into school if they have symptoms, have had a positive test result in the last 10 days, or if there are other reasons requiring them to stay at home due to the risk of them passing on Covid-19. Individuals are not required to self-isolate if they live in the same household as someone with Covid-19, or are a close contact of someone with Covid-19, and any of the following apply:

- they are fully vaccinated (at least 2 weeks following second vaccine dose);
- they are below the age of 18 years and 6 months;
- they have taken part in or are currently part of an approved Covid-19 vaccine trial;
- they are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

Please ensure that you keep us informed of any symptoms, tests or diagnosis so that we can be mindful in school.
