Dear School Families,



We have continued to log positive cases during this week and as such we officially have an 'outbreak' in school. We have been in daily communication with the Health Protection Team (HPT) and they are supporting us in tracking the cases to ensure all guidance is being followed. Thankfully, we reacted quickly with increased mitigations and so are several days ahead in terms of minimising contact and risk. We sincerely hope that this provides a 'circuit breaker' and protects the run up to Christmas.

We have been made aware with our recent experience of NHS Test and Trace, that the difference between positive test date and connection with symptoms can mean that the official out-of-isolation date is sooner than anticipated. The HPT are aware of this and see this as a potential concern. Therefore, as we continue on our learning curve, we will be very specific when logging absences or discussing the seasonal cough, colds and ills. If your child has any ailment(s) which may be typical of this time of year and you feel they can still attend school, should a positive covid test occur, we request that this is NOT counted as the start of symptoms as you could be seasonally poorly, with asymptomatic covid. If at any point you or your child feels unwell, the list of symptoms is increasing beyond the main three making it so incredibly difficult for us all to diagnose.
