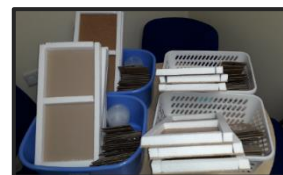

Christmas Covid On-call

I want to approach the last two weeks of term thinking of lovely Christmas things and the successes in our term's learning rather than mentioning lots of details in relation to Covid-19. So I am taking this opportunity to highlight an important message in relation to the Christmas holidays and the need to keep us informed:

- 1) If a member of staff or child has symptoms before Sunday 20th December, please call the Covid-line **07938 642536**. If this is not answered, call back or email enquiries@eagle.lincs.sch.uk and ensure that you **take a test**.
- 2) If a member of staff or child has a **positive** test result before Sunday 20th December we **MUST** be informed using the contact above and we will contact the Health Protection Team. The most likely outcome will be that all class members will have to self-isolate for 14 days over the Christmas period.
- 3) If you have symptoms and/or positive test results occur after Sunday 20th December please follow the details given to you with your results information. You can let us know via email for our records and highlight the calculated return date following self-isolation.
