COVID Update

The government has lifted the Plan B measures from Thursday 27th January. Whilst this means that there is no longer a legal requirement to wear a face covering, the government suggests that you continue to wear a face covering in crowded and enclosed spaces or where you may come into contact with people you do not normally meet. Therefore, we will respect personal choice, but ask that face coverings be worn during the upcoming parent consultations.

For us in school, this means that we will start moving back to the plans established for our September return prior to the outbreak before Christmas. We will gradually move back to these mitigations as there are only two weeks left of this term and so (all being well) we can come back after February half term with minimal restrictions.



So from **Monday 31st January:**

- School gates will open at 8.45am (please wait with your child unless they are in Year 6)
- Children will be welcomed into school and registered at 8.55am
- Gates will be closed by 9.00am
- Current Key Stage toilet organisation will remain until Term 4 (indoor activity)
- Current Key Stage lunch arrangement will remain until Term 4 (indoor activity)
- Key Stage mixing will be allowed at break time (outdoor activity)

Polite Request

If you happen to walk through the staff car park on your way into the building, please do not allow your children to walk next to the cars, lean on them, rest items against them or play near them as we have recently had damage reported.



Furthermore, please consider your parking when coming to the school site. Be aware of the school safety zone and ensure that you park respectfully ie do not block driveways or prevent spaces being accessed in the lay-by. Thank you 😊
