Dear Parents/Carers

Ouch - sore, dry hands

For some, coming back to full school opening has meant their hands getting back used to the regular hand washing during the day (often with hasty drying!) and this is causing sore, dry hands. We have experienced this before back in the Autumn term and so our classroom reminders are ongoing. We have various types of soap accessible and I have purchased Aloe Vera/Moisturising, anti-bacterial soap for the classrooms. We also have on order an alternative type of paper towel which we hope will encourage more effective drying. Nevertheless, we know how sore dry hands can get. If you can help remind your child(ren) of the hand-washing message, in particular to rinse and dry properly that would be greatly appreciated. Also, if you feel that a soothing product is required (which may help repair and protect over the Easter break and upon our return), advice is to recommend an emollient which offers a moisturising treatment and can be applied directly to the skin to soothe and hydrate it. They then cover the skin with a protective film to trap in moisture and help to manage dry or itchy skin. I have sought advice from a pharmacist and the best options are Cetraben and Epaderm, which are the next step up after E45-type hand creams.
